Training Class

Wednesday, June 26, 2019
0800-1700 hours

Cold Stop Criminal Interdiction

CNOA Region 1 and NCHIDTA are jointly hosting this informative class. The class will emphasize the use of common-sense criminal interdiction aspects to identify criminal activity taking place during a routine traffic stop. It will focus on the ability to detect deceptive registration, deceptive registered owners implausible travel plans, physical behavior linked to stress, and criminal activity such as drug trafficking or bulk money laundering. The class will discuss case law on proper traffic stops, how to conduct a proper search identifying and locating hidden compartments, and how to process and conduct a post seizure investigation. Other areas discussed will be;

- Identifying driving behavior
- Security vehicles and cloned vehicles
- Locating drug trafficking organization and TCO installed GPS tracking devices
- Vetting subjects for control deliveries.

This course will also touch on preparing a report for the D.A., discussing the case with your D.A., and how to conduct a proper wall stop.

Instructor: Theodore Peterson has been with the Riverside County Sheriff's Dept for almost 22 years, 12 of those years have been working nothing but interdiction with a drug trained single purpose K9. He has taught classes at the national level including classes with the CNOA. Ted was a member of the 2012 and 2016 interdiction teams of the year for the National Criminal Enforcement Association at the national interdiction conferences. He has received additional awards as interaction officer of the year for 2017 and over 13 other nationally recognized awards for various drug and bulk currency seizures since 2008. Ted has an advanced P.O.S.T., a bachelor's degree in criminal justice, and served 4 years in the United States Marine Corps. He has close to 800 arrests and investigations into drug trafficking and has located over 300 hidden compartments. The drugs seized since 2007 are in the ton range, not including marijuana with over 8 million in bulk currency seized along with 9 kilos of gold bars.
