Parcel Interdiction

Course Description: This class will provide an overview of Criminal Interdiction investigation techniques, including methods of conducting an Interdiction operation at public conveyances facilities such as airlines, trains, buses and commercial freight and parcel couriers. The course will provide legal parameters in conducting Interdiction investigations at public conveyances. In the afternoon the course will emphasis and provide students with an advanced training on parcel interdiction investigations, discussing interview techniques, the use of K-9, recent court decisions and search warrant writing techniques.

Instructor: James Meek started his career as a Special Agent with the California Department of Justice in 1999. SA Meek was assigned to the Bureau of Narcotic Enforcement (BNE), Sacramento Regional Office. During his 12 year tenure with the BNE, he was assigned to the Special Operations Unit, Marijuana Investigations Team (HIDTA) and the Criminal Interdiction Team. In each of those assignments he conducted complex criminal investigations involving poly-Drug Trafficking Organizations (DTO) who organized the finance, trafficking, and distribution of narcotics. The Criminal Interdiction investigations focused on organizations engaged in the importation of illicit drug money and exportation of drugs from California utilizing public conveyances - airlines, trains, busses, and commercial freight and parcel couriers.
