Course Objectives:

- Effective threat management strategies
- Fundamentals of behavioral threat assessment
- Techniques for conducting behavioral threat assessment interviews & interrogations
- Application of behavioral threat assessment techniques in a variety of contexts and environments including (but not limited to) the workplace, schools, places of worship, and all other potentially vulnerable areas in the community.

Target Audience / Discipline:

This instruction is designed for the Terrorism Liaison Officers (TLO's) and/or Active Public Safety / Government First Responders (Police, Fire, EMS, Health, Human Services, schools, etc.) in direct support of the TLO Program in the NCRIC's Area of Operation (AOR).
