Warrant Service Operations: Safeguarding The Process

CNOA Region 1 and NCHIDTA are jointly hosting this first of a series of 3 courses that build on each other. Attending this course is a pre-requisite for the next course.

The service of warrants by law enforcement teams is a high-liability decision that involves significant safety and legal ramifications. This seminar will challenge personnel to engage and ensure that they have asked the hard questions of themselves and their team. Why is your team being utilized for specific missions? Why is it that your team functions in the way that it does? Why are specific tactics chosen? And just as important, what consistent process is utilized within your team and agency to ensure that proper and effective decisions are made prior to the deployment of your team. Having efficient but thorough systems and processes in place allows for leadership development, proper decision making and protection for the team, agency and personnel.

Instructor: Mark Schlegel is a 30-year veteran of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department. His professional history includes a mix of operational law enforcement, special weapons and tactics, leadership development and tactical training experience. As an accomplished consultant, Mark has worked as an instructor for a number of national law enforcement training organizations and has trained over 10,000 law enforcement, military, international police services personnel across the US, Canada and abroad.
